HKAC Dept of Psychology Part-Time Certificate Program in Christian Counseling

n January 2022, HKAC's Department of Psychology was very pleased to have officially launched a part-time, Monday evenings and Sunday mornings based, certificate program in Christian Counseling. There are four compulsory courses in the program: PSYC110, RELT110, PSYC201, and PSYC202. Plus, enrolled students select two out of four available elective courses. All courses are taught in Cantonese Chinese and are supplemented in English, in hybrid or fully online mode, and are tailored for church leaders and church members who would like to receive basic Christian counselling training. This is a sixteen credits certificate program involving six courses. Each course is worth three academic credits.

PSYC201 (Introduction to Mental Health and Mental Health First Aid), was launched on April 25, 2022 and was taught mainly in the Zoom online, live lectures format. Upon completion of the PSYC201 course requirements, enrolled students were rewarded with the Mental Health First Aid Certificate by the Mental Health Association of Hong Kong. Dr. Anna Liu-Chim, who is a certified instructor for this course.

Since PSYC201 is a prerequisite of the next course in the certificate program, PSYC202 (Basic Counseling Skills), those who are interested in finding out more or in enrolling with permission can contact Dr. Anna Liu-Chim or Ms. Priscilla Wong (Chairwoman, HKAC Department of Psychology) via email (see bottom right). Due to the design of the program, the enrolment quota for PSYC201 was kept to 15 students. The next course, PSYC202 (Basic Counseling Skills) is anticipated to be taught from September 19th to December 19th 2022. 

We hope your visits will allow you to reminisce about your nostalgic, happy school days.












