



BBA - Accounting

Accounting is concerned primarily with (1) measuring income, expenditures, and wealth generated by a business enterprise, and (2) communicating information about the financial condition of economic organizations and the results of their financial activities. Thus, accounting is the language of business - the backbone of the free enterprise system.

The accounting major is designed to meet the needs of students preparing for accounting careers in business, government, not-for-profit organizations, or public accounting, including those who desire to secure, through state examination, the status of Certified Public Accountant (CPA) or that of Certified Management Accountant (CMA).


BBA-Finance

2+2 DEGREE PROGRAM

The "2+2 Degree Program" is a specialized study plan designed for students enrolled in a locally registered, "Non-Local Affiliated Program" through Andrews University at Hong Kong Adventist College. This program allows the transfer of credits earned in Hong Kong to bachelor programs offered by Andrews University or other universities in the United States. The program is tailored to meet the diverse needs of students.

To participate in the program, students must complete at least one or two years of affiliated bachelor program at Hong Kong Adventist College. Once their academic performance meets the necessary standards, students can transfer their credits to Andrews University or other sister universities in the United States. Upon their arrival in the United States, students can complete their bachelor degree within approximately two to three years. During this period, they are eligible to receive a substantial tuition scholarship of up to 50%.

SCHOLARSHIP

Through the 2+2 Degree Program, students transfer to Andrews University will be eligible for a scholarship of US\$14,000 (or around HK\$109,200) per year while studying in the state.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS for Year 3 entry

- Must completed the General Business Associate degree program at Hong Kong Adventist College
- A minimal overall CGPA of 2.50 or higher is required
- Fulfil the English Language Proficiency, Level 3 in English Language in HKDSE, or IELTS 6.5, or TOEFL IBT 80, or Passed the English Language Program at Hong Kong Adventist College
